

## EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

The Town of Weldon will accept applications for the position of Distribution-Collection Operator. Applicant must be a high school graduate or possess GED with prior experience or interest in water and sewer piping systems. Basic knowledge of, or ability to learn and practice water and sewer utility piping procedures and maintenance, main taps, power equipment operation, willingness and physical ability to perform manual labor in extreme weather conditions; ability to understand and transmit simple oral and written instructions; trench safety; ability to keep equipment, tools and vehicles in good working condition; good physical condition; must maintain a telephone at place of residence; must obtain and wear, at own expense, an approved pair of steel-toed safety shoes.

Position requires after hours call out and “on-call”.

Applicant must have a Collection System Operator Grade 1 License issued by the North Carolina Water Pollution Control System Operators Certification Commission or ability to obtain a Grade 1 Collection System Operator’s License within 12 months of date hired.
